LARC 4001 - LANDSCAPE STUDIO 1

Landscape Studio I focuses on regional scale analysis and site-specific design development. We will explore the relationship between people and abandoned landscapes with a focus on green infrastructural planning and design.

This project will require you to critically examine the larger Nova Scotia landscape and its multiple interconnections to a remnant wetland pond and the small community which receives an influx of tourists in the summer.

Is a neglected pond currently undergoing successional ecosystem change a good thing for the region and the landscape? Or are there opportunities to enhance its multifaceted ecosystem services?

What are the indigenous, socio-cultural and historical influences within the region in which to generate design ideas?

How can your design reactivate this important component of the town's hydrological system and serve as a greenspace asset to the local community?
